

## Take part in our property survey and help us future proof our homes.

Radius Housing has recently commissioned Savills (a surveying company) to carry out condition surveys to Radius properties across Northern Ireland.

An initial pilot survey of 2,500 properties will take place in the upcoming months.

These surveys are designed to help give us a better understanding of the condition of our homes.

The surveys will play a vital role as Radius reviews and plans future maintenance and improvement work, such as replacement kitchens, bathrooms, windows and doors, ensuring our homes remain energy efficient and are maintained to a high standard.



Initially a Savills surveyor will be in your area undertaking inspections on a door to door basis.



All surveyors will carry a Savills photo ID badge and a letter of authority on Radius headed paper. You should ask to see both before allowing access to your home, if you have any concerns please call Radius for verification.

If you are not at home when the surveyor visits, a calling card will be delivered asking you to contact Savills directly to make suitable alternative arrangements.

Awarded by Keep NI Beautiful for the high standard of their outdoor green space, recognising the hard work and dedication from tenants.

The Green Flag Award is a benchmark national standard for parks and green spaces and was first launched in Northern Ireland in 2008, recognising and rewarding the best green spaces in the country.

Radius Housing continue to be the only Housing Association to achieve this award. At the awards ceremony which took place at the beautiful Walled Gardens in Bangor, representatives from the schemes were presented with their Green Flag from the DAERA Minister
